For all transverse, high wear and high traffic areas, thermoplastic line marking can be installed via our self-propelled applicators, by hand screed or by pre-formed thermoplastic. Including: stop lines, barrier lines, arrows, crossings and text.



Line Removal

We can remove all types of road marking using our modern line grinders. Our experienced crews can minimise pavement damage caused by grinding using fine adjustments and multiple passes, leaving no traces of previous lines. Alternatively, blackout paint can be used to blend in and hide lines.



Coloured Surfacing

Available in a wide range of colours, both paint and cold applied plastic can be used to delineate bus lanes, bicycle lanes and pedestrian areas. Skid resistance can be added using fine stones, coarse sands and grits.



Raised Pavement Markers

Raised Pavement Markers can be installed in any quantity from just a few on an intersection to more than 3,000 per shift on main roads. We use a variety of hot-melt and epoxy application methods to ensure maximum adhesion and longevity.
